LIBRARY GUIDELINES

In order to protect the health and safety of both patrons and staff, public health procedures have been instituted for all patrons visiting the libraries.

- Face masks are requested for all individuals, vaccinated as well as unvaccinated.
- No children under the age of 10 without an accompanying adult 18 years or older.
- Unvaccinated patrons are requested to observe 6-foot social distancing.
- All meeting rooms are closed to the public.

Any patron who does not comply with these guidelines will be asked to leave the library immediately.

- Notary services by appointment.
- Contactless Home Delivery service for homebound patrons.
- W-E Browse: Customized picks of available materials which can be picked up via curbside.
- 3D Printing at Eastlake Library.
- Study rooms are now open to the public.
