

The Willoughby-Eastlake Public Library continues to strive to provide high-quality public library service to the seven communities that we serve.

2017 saw the completion of two major renovations projects at the Willoughby and Willowick libraries along with the installation of additional upgraded computers for the use of our patrons at all four of our Libraries. Portable WiFi Hot Spots and tablet computers are now available for check-out.
